At Girls Inc., we create a pathway that molds possibility into reality! And every step she takes forward becomes part of our shared legacy.

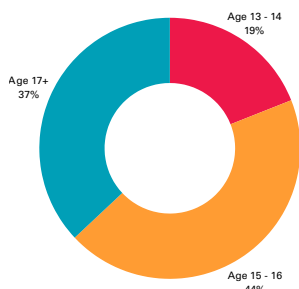
What is the BOLD Leaders Summit?

Girls will rotate through three dynamic tracks—**Strong, Smart, and Bold**—each intentionally designed to develop confidence, critical thinking, and leadership skills. Along the way, they will connect with accomplished women leaders, expand their networks, and see firsthand the possibilities within their reach. Our Summit intentionally aligns with the annual celebration of International Day of the Girl.

Anchored in this year's theme, *Her Journey. Our Legacy.*, the Summit highlights the power of individual growth and collective impact, empowering girls to shape their own futures while contributing to a lasting legacy for generations to come.

While participants engage in workshops, parents and caregivers will take part in curated breakout sessions focused on college and career readiness, confidence-building, and meaningful ways to support their daughters' aspirations. 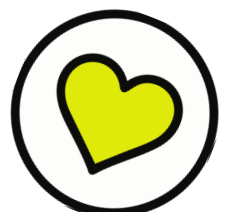

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Where do the funds go?

Funds cover the cost of the girls attending the Summit, meals, supplies, etc., during the Summit. Additionally, funds raised help support overall year-round programming, supplies, scholarships, transportation, etc., as our year-round programs, workshops, spring and summer camps, and summit are provided at no cost to the girls and families we serve.

Is my donation tax-deductible?
